This directive authorizes the archiving of SPS?\_INTERSECTIONS, SPS?\_PROJECT\_STATIONS, and SPS?\_CUT\_FILL\_LOCATIONS tables in accordance with Directive I-58: Disposition of Obsolete or Rejected LTPP IMS Data and Archiving.

These tables are considered obsolete with the creation of the SPS\_PROJECT\_STATIONS, SPS\_INTERSECTIONS, and SPS\_CUT\_FILL\_LOCATIONS tables which consolidated the information in the tables to be archived. The new tables replaced the existing versions in all QC which referenced these location reference tables.

The TSSC will provide the necessary instructions for the regions to drop the tables from the IMS. The TSSC is responsible for archiving the tables for future reference. All of these actions will be completed prior to the March 2001 upload.
