


Subject: Addition of DNC 690D Longitudinal Profile Data to AIMS

The electronic data files from the LTPP operated KJ Law DNC 690D longitudinal profilers shall be added to the Ancillary Information Management System (AIMS) following the directory structure for high speed profilers specified in LTPP Directive GO-48. The profile data do not need to be converted to ERD file format. The file naming conventions used at the time the files were created shall be used. The intent of this activity is to store the profile data files covered in LTPP Directive P-7 "Handling and Long-Storage of Profile Data" which have been restored to original format from the Fastback Plus or PKZIP compressed formats. Addition of these file to the AIMS shall be completed prior to the next public extraction of AIMS files.

Please contact your designated FHWA Contract Officer Representative if you are not able to complete processing and upload of the required AIMS files by this date.
