

Subject: Implementation of Web Enabled LTPP Data Entry Portal

Effective September 30, 2011 (known as the Go-live date), the LTPP Regional Support Contractors (RSC) shall begin using the LTPP Data Entry Portal (LDEP) to load new data into the Pavement Performance Data Base (PPDB) using the LDEP Production Instance. There will be a dual-entry period (validation period) wherein the RSC shall process all new data in both the LDEP and existing regional LTPP Regional Information Management System (RIMS) PPDB databases.

At the end of the validation period on November 23, 2011, the RSC will provide an upload from the regional databases to the TSSC for comparison purposes by November 28, 2011. TSSC shall provide scripts and instructions for this upload to the RSC at least one week prior to the upload. All data entry in the LTPP LDEP and LTPP PPDB will be suspended from November 24 to December 1, 2011 while the comparison is done.

The FHWA RSC COTR will provide direction to the RSCs on further processing using LDEP after the comparison testing period.
