
On August 7, 2012, the Public Data Extraction (PDE) will be performed from the Information Management System Production instance (IMSPROD) on the LTPP Data Entry Portal (LDEP). By 12 pm Pacific time on August 7, 2012, the Regional Support Contractors shall have completed the following:

- Entry of each portion of multi-part data sets.
- Changes in response to data checks reported at least 30 days prior to the PDE date.
- Compute annual traffic estimates for sites in the SPS WIM Traffic Pooled Fund study.
- Run Quality Control (QC) programs and complete QC processing on all data in the production instance.
- Update EXPERIMENT_SECTION with known construction events.
- Removal of pavement monitoring and construction data after the effective date of a test section status change to “out-of-study”.

The Technical Support Services Contractor (TSSC) will turn off access to the LDEP IMSPROD during the PDE. The production instance will reopen by 12 pm Pacific time on August 14, 2012. The TSSC will send out an announcement to the LTPP team if IMSPROD is reopened before this date.
