This directive implements the procedures for handling the deletion of "EXPERIMENT\_SECTION" data from the LTPP database.

The sections with STATUS = R in the **EXPERIMENT\_SECTION** table which was current as of January 17, 1999 are defined to be "rejected." Insufficient basic information has been collected to make these sections eligible for any type of analysis. This data for these sections is selected for deletion and follows the procedures described under the terms of **IMS Directive I-58, "Deletion of Obsolete or Rejected LTPP Data."**

The sections to be deleted are:

The regions are to make the deletions using the "System-Wide Section Maintenance" function prior to the May 1999 upload. The TSSC will delete this section data from the release database. All data associated with these sections is to be removed from the IMS as of the May 1999 upload.

A copy of all data collection materials which support entry of data into the IMS will be forwarded to the TSSC for storage by May 31, 1999. The originals of all material pertaining to these sections will be consolidated within each region for any further required actions by May 31, 1999.
