SMP_ATEMP_RAIN_DAY	Update of selected MAX_ATEMP_TIME and MIN_ATEMP_TIME
MON_DIS_AC_REV	Deletion of regional specified surveys
MON_DIS_CRCPC_REV	Deletion of regional specified surveys
MON_DIS_JPCC_REV	Deletion of regional specified surveys

1. Create the subdirectory RELEASES/table_mods_1_0 (the directory RELEASES should already exist).
2. Copy the entire contents of forthcoming CD titled "Post datapave 3.0 table updates" dated 6/14/2001.
3. From COMMAND prompt type UPDATE_TABS username/password@service_name (example: UPDATE_TABS NARO/NARO@NARODB) to begin update table processing. Review all generated log/lst files. Report any problems to the TSSC.
