Subject:	Upgrade of K.J. Law Software

This directive has been prepared for purposes of upgrading, effective immediately, the K.J. Law software so that IRI values computed by that software agree with those generated by the PROQUAL program. Differences in IRI values were being caused by the method used by the K.J. Law software to convert 25-mm profile data to averaged 150-mm data. To address that problem, the four K.J. Law files used in the computation of the IRI value were modified.

The enclosed disk contains the four modified K.J. Law files. They are: onesix.exe, index\_sb.exe, compiri.exe, and mainmenu.exe. These four files should be copied into the KJL\_SYST directory, overwriting the files that are currently there. Prior to copying these files, make a backup of the existing files, so if any problems are encountered with the new files, the old files can be restored.
