Enclosed you will find five CDs that contain Standard Data Release 19.0 for the Long-Term Pavement Performance (LTPP) Program. The full suite of data is contained in this data set. The data is collected into groups of tables based on data module. Two large tables, MON\_DEFL\_DROP\_DATA and MON\_PROFILE\_DATA, have been divided by groups of states and provinces. Each data module is provided in Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Access 2000 databases that have been zipped to save disk space. Double-click on each file and follow instructions to unzip. A list of the contents of each CD is enclosed with this package.

The first CD contains several documents and software programs contained in directories, as listed below:

- Table Navigator software - This software combines the contents of the reference documents (Database Schema, Data Dictionary, and Codes List) into a searchable database.
- ESALCalc software - Software for calculating ESAL values.
- Reference Documents - This directory contains the *LTPP Information Management System: IMS Quality Control Checks (August 2003)*, the *LTPP Pavement Performance Database Release Notes* (hardcopy included in this package), the *Data Analysis/Operations Feedback Report* instruction letter and form, and the *Pavement Performance Database User Reference Guide (January 2005)*, which provides specific information about each data module and the many data tables).
- Quick Start - contains an electronic copy of the *Data Module Listing, Accessing LTPP Data* (which is an introduction in to using Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Access 2000), and *Quick Start to LTPP Standard Data Release* (which provides a quick reference to the LTPP data).
